### Street Jesus News:

**And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.**

**1 Peter 3:15-16**

Welcome to the April edition of Street Jesus e news. It was great to spend Palm Sunday at my anchor church in Wickham Market. Increasingly we are visiting other churches on Sundays to make people aware of the Street Jesus project and invite people to join with us, to come out and be a Christian witness in public places. We had a thoroughly enjoyable day at St Margarets church in Leiston on March 18th where we received the warmest of welcomes on what was a freezing cold day. We really appreciated their encouragement. When we talk together we remind ourselves of why we are doing what we do and at our Palm Sunday service Jenny reminded us both of the unchanging nature of God and of his constant presence in our lives. So whilst we may have certain trends and expressions in the Christian community God is the same yesterday, today and for evermore.



At Easter we are looking at our place in eternity, won for us with Christs victory over sin and death whereby all we need do is embrace our Lord and saviour with arms open wide as he opened his arms to us in love on the cross.



Also at our Palm Sunday service Kerry gave us the image of bread as a mix of flour and yeast. In that state you cannot spread butter or marmalade on it. You need to go through a process to get that wonderful warm loaf to enjoy. It is the same in our life of growing closer to God. Sometimes in our Christian walk we get difficulties and problems along the way, a bit like when we are kneading the dough, it can stick to our fingers and be difficult to shake off. On a personal level the most challenging part of ministry for me is talking publicly to large groups of people but its interesting how God sometimes places us in situations where we do not feel entirely comfortable. During my talk at Leiston it may have felt like sticky dough at times but with Gods help hopefully there was enough of a warm loaf for others to consume and enjoy at the end. Is God wanting you to do something which you feel uncomfortable with? It may be that you too need to get kneading to get more of that wonderful bread of life to share with others. It is with eager anticipation then that we look toward to Easter to both reflect

and celebrate. On Good Friday we will be taking part in the march of witness in Wickham Market which is an annual event and was very well attended last year. Evangelina the Street Jesus van takes part in the procession, with the vital message of LOVE-HOPE-FREEDOM-JUST AS YOU ARE.

On Easter Saturday we will be on the Triangle at the top of Hamilton road in Felixstowe 10am -4pm. This is a venue we attended last year and our prayer is that it will be some bit warmer this year and that there are no road works getting in the way, so that we can meet and speak with many more people on the day

On April 7th we will be holding our bi-annual yard sale here at Featherbroom gardens in Wickham Market. These have become increasingly popular and we hope yet again to be able to support the Beehive Kenya with vital resources and raise awareness of the Christian work there. As you can see we have plenty to look forward too and are very excited about the programme for the months ahead, We are in the process of applying for three further events in July and August and will let you know as these are confirmed.
