
At Easter we are looking at our place in eternity, won for us with Christs victory over sin and death whereby all we need do is embrace our Lord and saviour with arms open wide as he opened his arms to us in love on the cross.



Also at our Palm Sunday service Kerry gave us the image of bread as a mix of flour and yeast. In that state you cannot spread butter or marmalade on it. You need to go through a process to get that wonderful warm loaf to enjoy. It is the same in our life of growing closer to God. Sometimes in our Christian walk we get difficulties and problems along the way, a bit like when we are kneading the dough, it can stick to our fingers and be difficult to shake off. On a

personal level the most challenging part of ministry for me is talking publicly to large groups of people but its interesting how God sometimes places us in situations where we do not feel entirely comfortable. During my talk at Leiston it may have felt like sticky

dough at times but with Gods help hopefully there was enough of a warm loaf for others to consume and enjoy at the end. Is God wanting you to do something which you feel uncomfortable with? It may be that you too need to get kneading to get more of that wonderful bread of life to share with others. It is with eager anticipation then that we look toward to Easter to both reflect

and celebrate. On Good Friday we will be taking part in the march of witness in Wickham Market which is an annual event and was very well attended last year. Evangelina the Street Jesus van takes part in the procession, with the vital message of LOVE-HOPE-FREEDOM-JUST AS YOU ARE.





Since Hope House opened in North Wales in April 1996 it has been offering women the opportunity to break free from long term drug and alcohol addiction and to re-engage with the normal course of everyday life. The founder and first manager was Audrey Rankin whose pioneering spirit and total commitment to her call from God means that Hope House is one of the most successful female residential drug ministries in the UK. Since Audrey tragically died in 2003 her book "Treasures of Hope" has been an inspiration to many. A second book "Voices of Hope" by Fiona Fallon tells the stories of a number of women who have made the journey from depths of despair to a life of true liberty.
