enjoyed. As afternoon went by many of the members shared their own experiences which was both interesting and a blessing. I love those talks which end up as a conversation and this was one such occasion.

The Mothers Union organisation has a long and interesting history having been formed in 1876 by Mary Sumner a rectors wife. It has a vision of a world where Gods love is shown through loving respectful and flourishing relationships. Although it was set up to support mothers from all backgrounds in the difficult task of raising children it also promotes all kinds of nurturing and is not exclusively for mothers. There are many men who are also members. Its purpose is to demonstrate the Christian faith in action by the transformation of communities worldwide through the nurture of families in its many forms. The aims are to uphold Christs teaching on the nature of marriage and promote its wider understanding, to encourage parents to bring up their children in the life of the church, to maintain a worldwide fellowship of Christians united in prayer, worship and service and to promote conditions in society favourable to stable family life and the protection of children including supporting whose whose family life has met with adversity. In our bible passage this month from the book of Daniel we read of Shadrach Meshach and Abednigo being bound and thrown into the furnace by King Nebuchadnezzar. The King is amazed to find that they are walking around in the furnace with an angel and have not been touched by the flames. The King orders that all should worship their God not least because of their willingness to enter the furnace fully trusting in God but also because of Gods protection.

This is a foreshadowing of Christ giving himself over to the authorities before his crucifixion. For us the message is about keeping that faith despite the adversity that inevitably comes in life and that our response to trouble may also convince others to follow God.

At the end of October many will be celebrating Halloween and the big supermarket chains will be going into overdrive attempting to sell all sorts of weird costumes and props. For many this is seen as just a bit of harmless fun for children to enjoy. For us as Christians we know there is a darker side to all this and that occult practices are still performed right across the country. Why celebrate darkness rather than light? evil rather than good? Coercion rather than giving? As Christians we can do something positive at Halloween. Lets take the trick out of treating and just treat others.

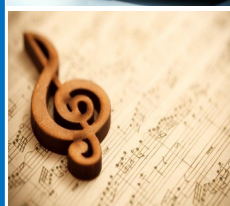

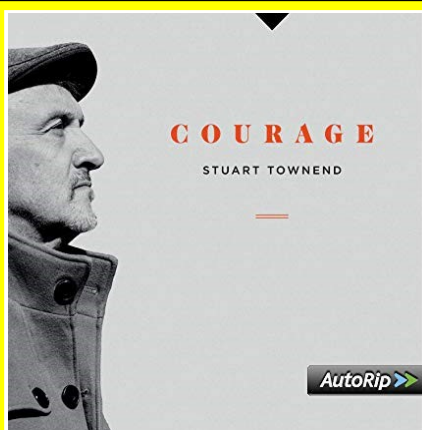

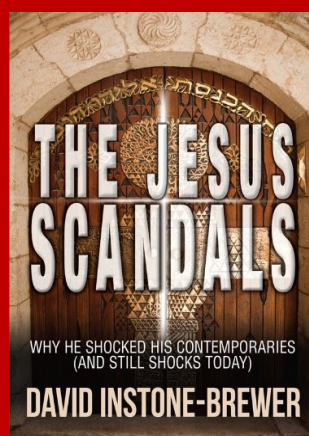

## Bible reading

Nebuchadnezzar was so furious with Shadrach Meshach and Abednego that his face became distorted with rage. He commanded that the furnace be heated seven times hotter than usual. Then he ordered some of the strongest men of the army to bind Shadrach Meshach and Abednego and throw them into the blazing furnace. So they tied them up and threw them into the furnace, fully dressed in their pants, turbans, robes and other garments and because the King in his anger, had demanded such a hot fire in the furnace the flames killed the soldiers as they threw the three men in. So Shadrach Meshach and Abednego securely tied fell into the roaring flames. But suddenly Nebuchadnezzar jumped up in amazement and exclaimed to his advisors "Didn't we tie up three men and throw them into the furnace?" "Yes your majesty we certainly did," they replied. "Look," Nebuchadnezzar shouted "I see four men unbound walking around in the fire unharmed and the fourth looks like God!" Then Nebuchadnezzar came as close as he could to the door of the flaming furnace and shouted "Shadrach Meshach and Abednego, servants of the most high God, Come out! Come here!"
