Street Jesus News:

And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.

1 Peter 3:15-16

Welcome to the February edition of Street Jesus e news. We hope you are all settling well into the new year and looking forward to the warmer weather and lighter evenings. In January we always take a break from our outreach programme. Its our sabbath, a time to rest, reflect and pray earnestly for the year ahead. Our outreach programme is building up nicely and we have 15 missions planned between now and the end of our financial year in July. We always welcome anybody who feel they would like to join us in going out, meeting people and showing the love of Christ on the street.

Have you ever experienced that situation where you keep bumping into somebody, with the feeling that it is somehow meant to be. Recently I kept meeting a chap named John who it turns out is a door to door evangelist who delivers the Good news newspaper. I make a point of visiting the Good news stand at the Suffolk show each year and it really is a paper full of good news and amazing testimonies, many of which are by people in the public eye. We all seem to be interested in one another's life stories and very often like to share our own. Its very encouraging that on my visits to customers I am increasingly seeing the good news paper in peoples homes. It's a brave thing to do in our culture to go door to door and speak with people, particularly as the Christian faith seems increasingly at odds with the spirit of the age. I am constantly amazed at the work being done by Christians in the local community and we of course share much of what's going on with you through this newsletter. Doing is what we do but speaking out is much harder. But speak we must because Christ has commissioned us to tell people about his teachings.



It was very encouraging to see the acquittal of the Pakistani Christian Asia Bibi who was convicted of Blasphemy after an argument with a Muslim woman for which she spent 8 years on death row. Her



recent acquittal, which has this week been upheld has resulted in widespread protests in Pakistan including calls for her to be hanged. For this reason i am so pleased that we do not have such a law in the UK. It will be interesting to see which country will offer her asylum and any that does will risk upsetting a section of their

own Muslim community. It is interesting that a former director of the BBC admitted that Christianity has a rougher ride in the media simply because it has broader shoulders. This does not seem fair but Jesus taught us not to expect acceptance but rather that we will be ridiculed and insulted by some because of our love for him. This is part of the sacrifice, the carrying of the cross but he promises that he is with us always when we are obedient to him. Speaking of



sacrifice we often find ourselves thinking of our partners out in Kenya, praying for all those at the Beehive. The Beehive is growing at a great pace as the need for love and protection is so vital for the increasing number of young girls in their care who have suffered the most terrible traumas. Providing education and opportunities for the future are at the heart of their work. Some of the girls are still needing sponsors to help them with the cost of their education and we pray that support can be found. We have been thinking about how best to equip ourselves to answer questions that people may ask of us and to look at strategies on how best to connect with people when out on the street. We have been speaking about attending the unbelievable conference in London in July but have recently learned of an organisation called outreach UK who run training days in East Anglia. When we have more details we will let you know for anybody who may be interested.



We are always looking at resources which may help us to grow closer to God and encourage one another. There is no substitute for the spiritual food that we find in the bible and in our prayer life but there is much that we can gain from one another. Christianity magazine recently highlighted the growing trend of YouTube Christian vloggers who are becoming very popular, particularly among the young, some of you may like to check out The bible project, Jon Jorgensen, Speak life, and Robert Barron.

Having been a regular now for many years we are again looking forward to Spring harvest. We find this festival so uplifting and an essential part in renewing our spiritual batteries. This year Spring harvest celebrates its 40th anniversary and we wonder how many people have come to know Jesus there over the years and become inspired to work for Gods kingdom here on earth. We always come away enthused

We are very excited to be going out to Leiston Co-op on Saturday February 9th 9am-4pm for our first outreach of the year. We hope to be joined by members of Churches in Leiston on the day.

On Saturday March 2nd we are hoping to attend the vintage market at Bentwaters, if space is not available because it does get fully booked sometimes, we will be attending the Friday Street car boot on Sunday 3rd.

In April we will again be holding one of our bi-annual yard sale's here at 7 Featherbroom Gardens in Wickham Market in aid of the Beehive. Our Easter Saturday outreach is not yet confirmed but we will be out either in Woodbridge or Felixstowe, we will confirm the venue in our March e-news

In our Church we have recently been looking at the book of Exodus, As I have grown in my faith I have become much more interested in the old testament. Early In my Christian journey I found the new testament far more accessible and although many passages seem harsh to contemporary eyes there is this wonderful wealth of rich threads that reveal deeper layers of meaning throughout the old scriptures

In our passage this month we note Gods promise to be with Moses when he felt inadequate and it is the same promise that he makes to each of us today. He is there with us in the untidy mess of life. He loves us by his most merciful grace. Gods blessings Graham
