Welcome to the April edition of Street Jesus e news. We have a bumper edition again this month as there is so much going on in our local Christian community. We are asked from time to time why our e-news is so long and the simple answer is that there is such a lot going on. All the events we present in colourful chunks so that as you scroll down you can easily pick out those events which you may be interested in. We want to include as much as possible because there may be just one event which only you are interested in. It may play a very important part in your individual faith journey and help you to grow closer to God.

As we approach Easter and throughout the time of lent we are reflecting on what God has done for

us through Jesus on the cross, we express this in our prayers but also by our acts of abstinence and sacrifice. Easter gives us a great opportunity to speak about our faith and we hope to do just that over the Easter period. We were joined by John Green who is new to our team and does a lot of door to door evangelism. He brought a few copies of the Good news newspaper which we gave to people free. We had some very good conversations ranging from the increasing age of Church congregations, religious teachings in schools and problems around employment for people with mental health problems, universal credit and homelessness.



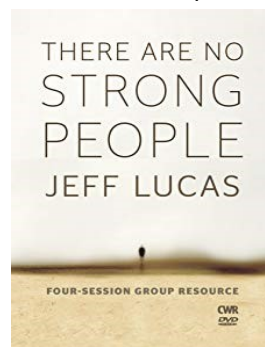
Our most interesting conversation was with a man who did not have a faith but was fascinated by two books he had read recently, one about Jesus and the other about Angels. His main point was that all religions were in effect a crutch from which people obtained comfort. This is in effect true and for us we are dependent upon Jesus for Gods saving grace and through prayer, the holy spirit to guide us.

Culturally we are taught the opposite, that there is virtue in being self reliant and independent. We spoke a bit about humility and honesty with ourselves in a culture that is keen to affirm everybody and everything. It is reported that many young people on social media become incredibly anxious about on line affirmation and getting likes .on their postings. Often after we have spoken to somebody we think

of something we could have said and because the man was obviously an avid reader i should have pointed him to a book by Jeff Lucas entitled 'There are no strong people. This book explores the paradox between strength and weakness.

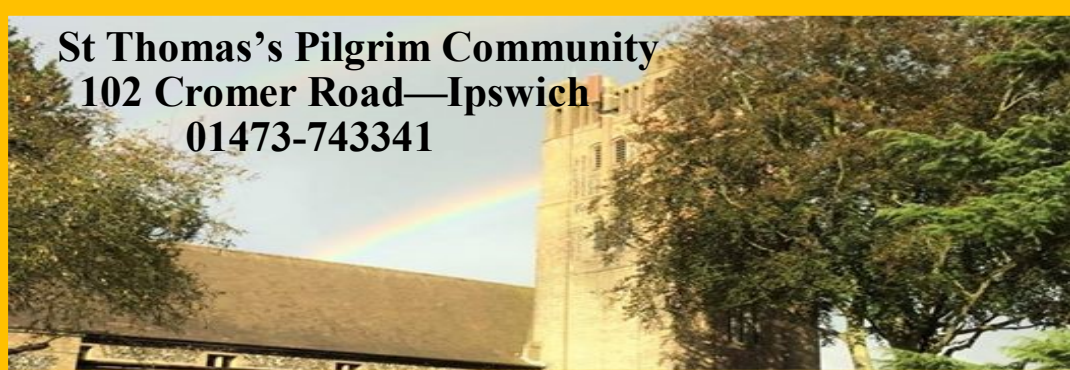

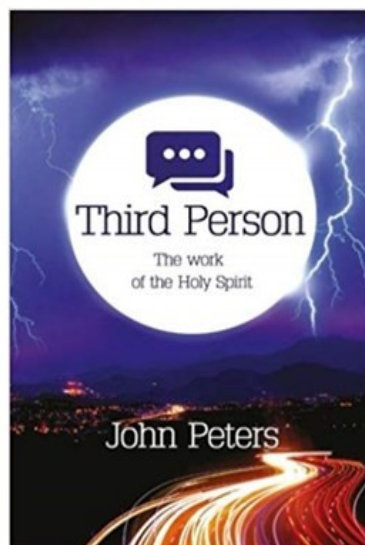

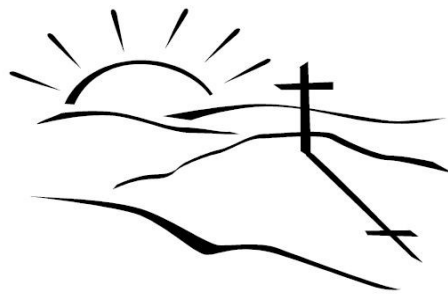

After a BA degree at Auckland University, New Zealand, Joan studied at the University of Otago, the British School of Archaeology and New College, Edinburgh University. She was then appointed lecturer (subsequently senior lecturer) at the University of Waikato, New Zealand. In 1995 she won an Innes Levi-Strauss Award in Israel's archaeology, for the book version of her PhD thesis, *Christians and the Holy Places* (Oxford: Clarendon, 1993, rev. 2003). In 1996-7 she was Visiting Lecturer and Research Associate in Women's Studies in New Testament at Harvard Divinity School, a position she held in association with a Fulbright Award. She has also been Honorary Research Fellow in the Departments of History and Jewish Studies at

University College London. She has taught at King's College London since 2009. She has written numerous books and articles in her fields of interest including the historical figures of Jesus of Nazareth, John the Baptist, Judas Iscariot, Paul, Pontius Pilate, Mary Magdalene, and other New Testament persons, both in terms of the ancient evidence and how they have been constructed over time, including in modern literature and film.
