

## Street Jesus News:

**And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.**

**1 Peter 3:15-16**

Welcome to the May edition of Street Jesus e news. We hope you had a very blessed Easter as we now look forward to the day of Pentecost and the birthday of the Church. We often say that the Church is not so much a building but a people. A body in which we are all connected. The Holy spirit moves among the people of God and its can be such an amazing feeling to be among our brothers and sisters in Christ in worship. We have recently been to Spring Harvest at Minehead and there is nothing quite like the enthusiasm that is generated there as we look to encourage one another.



**Holy Spirit**

The strap line for Spring Harvest this year was 'Unlimited' with prayer being the central theme. Most of the sessions looked at prayer in some form or other with all sorts of creative ways to connect with God being explored. The importance of prayer has been an almost constant theme recently with reminders coming my way very regularly so we will be reviewing how we approach our prayer support in our ministry at our next meeting.

The main bible teaching was presented by Anna Robbins who was simply awesome. She talked about moaning and groaning in prayer which is not to say that we should always be complaining to God but rather that there should be a greater longing in our prayers. This was quite challenging, as prayer can if we are not careful become a bit routine and lacking in feeling.

She also spoke about the dangers of Nostalgia and how without us realising, it can rob the young of hope. In a recent lecture in a UK university she asked the students if they thought things were better in the past than they are today. All of the students were incredulous 'Of course things were better in years gone by' added to which they were sure that it would not improve. I would have found this more depressing but for a recent visit to Exeter where there was a large

demonstration of students as part of the extinction rebellion movement. Regardless of how we view climate change it was heartening to see a sense of concern in young people about the future of the planet as i believe we have held a very nihilistic view within society in general in recent years where there has been a sense of helplessness and a lack of hope. This concern is well in keeping with our duty as Christians to be stewards of the creation and of course hope is a fruit of the Holy Spirit. The Swedish teenager who is the catalyst for the Extinction rebellion movement Greta Thunberg has been a beacon of hope, believing that something can be done.

So let's be a people of hope, after all the Christian story is one of the greatest hope and restoration.

On April 6th we held one of our bi-annual yard sales here in Wickham Market in aid of the Beehive. We were again pleased to share the work of the Beehive with visitors and £235 was raised for the cause. It was interesting that one lady who was not a Christian but thought that people of faith were subject to unfair prejudice in society as a whole. There are many Christians who take this view and of course Jesus tells us this will be so but it is very rare to hear this from a non-Christian.

On Easter Saturday we attended the War Memorial in Felixstowe and it was one of those days where despite hundreds of people being around on such a lovely day we did not get many visitors to the stall. This can be frustrating as we live to share the good news and desire to connect with people. Thankfully these days are rare. But one lady who visited was clearly upset. A dear friend had been very upset over the death of another friend. She had gone into Felixstowe to get a gift to help cheer her up. She spotted our floral candles and was delighted to see the Poppy design as her friend loved Poppies. We took a prayer request from her, she bought a candle and she just felt that we were meant to be there for her. Even on the quiet days God is at work. £31 was raised for the Beehive.





## Mary Magdalene in history, literature & film



After a BA degree at Auckland University, New Zealand, Joan studied at the University of Otago, the British School of Archaeology and New College, Edinburgh University. She was then appointed lecturer (subsequently senior lecturer) at the University of Waikato, New Zealand. In 1995 she won an Israel Levi-Strauss Award in Israel's archaeology, for the book version of her PhD thesis, *Christians and the Holy Places* (Oxford: Clarendon, 1993, rev. 2003). In 1996-7 she was Visiting Lecturer and Research Associate in Women's Studies in New Testament at Harvard Divinity School, a position she held in association with a Fulbright Award. She has also been Honorary Research Fellow in the Departments of History and Jewish Studies at

University College London. She has taught at King's College London since 2009. She has written numerous books and articles in her fields of interest including the historical figures of Jesus of Nazareth, John the Baptist, Judas Iscariot, Paul, Pontius Pilate, Mary Magdalene, and other New Testament persons, both in terms of the ancient evidence and how they have been constructed over time, including in modern literature and film.






