Street Jesus News:

And if somebody asks about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it, but do this in a gentle and respectful way.

1 Peter 3:15-16

Welcome to the October edition of Street Jesus e news. As ever this edition is packed with the many and varied Christian events coming up in the months ahead and we begin to look forward now to celebrating the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We certainly need something to look forward to as we as a nation continue to be unsettled by the whole Brexit scenario. We all no doubt have our own opinions on what should happen and there will be Christians on both sides of the Brexit debate. As somebody who found it quite difficult to decide which way to vote because there were so many pro's and cons in the debate, that's even considering what would be most biblical or saying what would Jesus do.



I cant help thinking that the whole issue has got somewhat out of perspective and that whichever way it goes (and God only knows which way it will go) our lives will only be impacted to a smaller degree than imagined and if there is some turbulence then it will hopefully settle down quite quickly.

I recently came across a verse in Isaiah 40:17 which talks about the nations being as nothing compared to God. When we become nationalistic we begin to create an icon that diminishes God.

The central argument for many in the Brexit debate is about sovereignty and who rules or controls, yet we remember how Jesus subverts political power at his trial and before Pilate.

The establishment were behaving badly then and in recent days the intemperate language used in parliament has only served to show that nothing much has changed. We understand that politics can raise



passions but the standard of debate has been very poor shedding more heat than light on the situation.

As various procedures and conventions have been flouted and rules bent on both sides, positions have become more entrenched and as in war truth has become the first casualty.

So whether we believe that sovereignty should be in Brussels or in London we know that there is really truly only one sovereign and that is King Jesus.

If the politicians, the supporters of each side and we ourselves (because we each carry these traits within us) could just follow his way then the aggression and fractiousness would dissipate and peace could be found. A world without the love of Jesus is a world of Weltschmerz (The German word for world pain)

So let us pray then that our country and the world can soon find a path to peace and unity under our Lord.



Street Jesus News:

Before we get to Christmas we have the festival of Halloween which takes on a negative feel for us as Christians. We do not celebrate anything that is spiritually dark. Jesus of course is the light of the world and its been very heartening to see Christians looking to provide positive alternatives to trick or treating. All hallows eve has a long history in many Christian traditions, of remembering the dead going back centuries (even though All souls day is on November 2nd) before we celebrate the life of the saints on November 1st

There is a growing trend for holding light parties in Churches as many parents feel less inclined to take their children out knocking on doors on a dark evening if there is a more positive alternative. I was reading recently of a large church that attracted nearly 1000 people, children dressed up as Angels and other biblical characters. The recently renovated building is owned by The Ansell Trust and is managed as a Day Retreat Centre by a team from the United Reformed Church and St Peter's Church.

THE FACILITIES

There is the main meeting room (seats up to 40) with a small kitchen area (for drinks and plating food), including washing up facilities and linen, along with glasses, crockery and cutlery for 40 people as well as supplies of tea, coffee and sugar.

There is also an electronic organ, keyboard and audio-visual equipment available for use. There are 2 toilets, one of which is wheelchair accessible, and there is space for parking at the front of the building and in close proximity.

THE QUIET PLACE

A short walk from the chapel is a five acre area of water meadow, preserved as a haven for wildlife by one of the centre's management team. In line with the vision and ethos of HOME, The Quiet Place is also available to individuals and groups on day retreat. You can follow a special trail with reflections or just stroll and sit and ponder. The distinctive wet meadow ecosystem is a natural home to special species of butterflies, birds and dragonflies.
