

Street Jesus News: Welcome to the August edition of our e-news.

We have spent much of July travelling, visiting family in Scotland and Guernsey. Both are beautiful in their very distinctive way. Most notable was the purple heather on Scottish hillsides and the wonderful hydrangeas in the channel islands. We give God all the glory for this beauty. On our way to Scotland we stopped off at Warrington and

visited a garden centre. Many garden centres now sell much more than items restricted to gardening with many other types of household items for sale. In the garden ornament section there were a number of Buddhas, we counted eleven different ones and wondered if the owner might be a Buddhist. These cross legged smiling figures are very popular as is Buddhism. Certainly when I was an atheist I was very attracted to it. There are many types of Buddhism as in many other religions. Ideas like mindfulness, meditation, reincarnation are immensely popular. Buddhism is





busy life here in the west. How regular is the practice of meditation and mindfulness or the reading of Buddhist teachings. These readings hold great wisdom and many of them mirror the teachings of Jesus in that they both subsume the self. Many who visit countries where Buddhism is practiced attest to the

peacefulness and kindness of the people So why if it and all the other positive sounding world views like Krishna, humanism and a number of philosophies are so good and positive, why would you choose Jesus instead? Having once asked a Buddhist how they dealt with their own personal sin it boiled down to using the spiritual techniques, and readings to help to bring about change.

As an Atheist when I got to the end of myself, my ego and self

resourcefulness i realised that there was a God waiting to redeem me. Realising I was powerless in my own strength, that I was dependent rather than independent and that Jesus died personally for me and my sin. Understanding this was a game changer

So why don't we have figures of Jesus in our garden centres? Apart from the fact that we are not to worship graven images, the whole imagery of a bloody suffering body in excruciating pain stands starkly against a cross legged smiling Buddha. People have asked us on the stall Why does God require a dead body as a sacrifice. The answer surely is that sin has a cost both to

Ourelves and others. It brings an inner spiritual death and separates us from the abundant life found in God. This whole idea is a reality that we do not wish to face. We prefer the idea that we can read some sayings and meditate to bring us some kind of peace. All we need is to be kind to one another and that Karma alone will bring people

what they deserve. If we do wrong we learn and will do better next time. All life is learning the Buddhist may say. How well does this reflect real life. The Christian teachings take a different path.

Christian teachings take a different path, we are to embrace that we are all sinners. This recognition should bring us to a point of humility. In an age of individualism



where choice and affirmation are king and the aim of life is to self actualise the teachings of Christ are a hard sell. We know that only Christ can do this for us, which is why we love him and take him into our hearts because he loved us first, not in some kind of dreamy romantic way but because in shedding his blood he showed it by his actions. The Buddhist aims for Nirvana, where the ego become extinguished and the person becomes as one with the universe. For Christians the presence of God exists now as well as into eternity, in the presence of love beauty joy and peace. It is an abundant rather than extinguished life. What an optimistic thought. What a promise for all who believe in him. It is the opposite of Karma. We get what we don't deserve.



We had a very fruitful and interesting outreach at the Ipswich music day. We had a strong team of eight out. We had lots of conversations and lots of pastoral care given. Prayer for healing for various physical and mental health issues as well as various relationship problems. On the subject of other faiths we had a very interesting conversation with two young Muslim men. It was great to have polite discourse which is a far cry from much of the debate seen every weekend at

speakers corner in Hyde park and some of the online conversations I have witnessed. The problem for them, as is usual was the whole concept of the Holy trinity, the one in three and the three in one. We talked about God being loving, intimate and knowable rather than a remote and distant God who may be all knowing and merciful but is distant and arbitrary in his judgement. We spoke of the Bible making over 600 references to Love whilst the Koran only a few but we mainly spoke about the Holy spirit being our helper, guide and comforter. We thanked each other for mutual respect as we listened intently to one another. We pray that they may come to know the lord. £165 was raised for the Beehive


