One of the great privileges of our work is to provide a listening ear to people who are hurting. Again we were able to speak with people who had connections with Nakuru with one person being very enthusiastic about going over to help. We were very pleased to be supported by those who visited and £80 was raised for the Beehive project Nakuru Kenya which was a great effort for a two hour event. We distributed 30 Beehive information sheets which generated a good bit of discussion about life in Kenya. Leiston Church have invited us back for an event in November and we are very grateful to have had the opportunity to meet with all the people there.



We had to postpone our August 5th mission to **Melton car boot sale**, it had been raining in the morning and we are very nervous about exposing the African wooden crafts to wet, as they are delicate and easily damaged. In any event Evangelina lost the power of acceleration and started billowing black smoke. Evangelina is now fully

All proceeds go directly to the Beehive and its worth reminding ourselves that these funds are vital to ensure the wellbeing of the child mothers and their babies over there in Kenya. 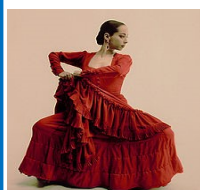

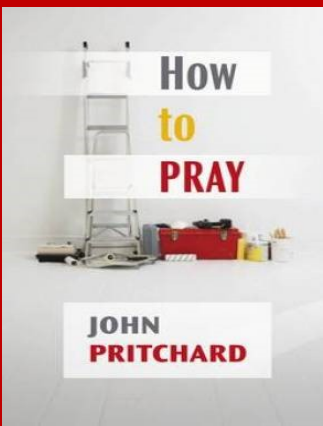

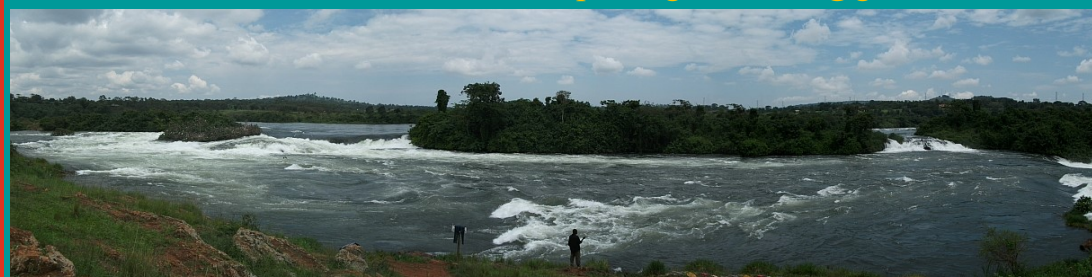

SUPPORTING CHILD MUMS AND THEIR BABIES AT THE BEEHIVE KENYA

Bible reading

After the lord had finished speaking to Job , he said to Eliphaz the Temanite. I am angry with you and your two friends for you have not spoken accurately about me as my servant Job has. So take seven bulls and seven rams and go to my servant Job and offer a burnt offering for yourselves. My servant Job will pray for you and i will accept his prayer on your behalf. I will not treat you as you deserve for you have not spoken accurately about me as my servant Job has. So Eliphaz the Temanite , Bildad the Shuhite and Zophar the Naamathite did as the lord commanded them, and the lord accepted Jobs prayer. When Job prayed for his friends the lord restored his fortunes, in fact the lord gave him twice as much as before! Then all his brothers sisters and former friends came and feasted with him in his home. And they consoled him and comforted him because of all the trials the lord has brought against him. And each of them brought him a gift of money and a gold ring. So the lord blessed Job in the second half of his life more than the beginning. For now he had 14,000 Sheep, 6,000 Camels, 1,000 teams of Oxen and 1,000 female Donkeys. He also gave Job seven more sons and three daughters. He named his first daughter Jemimah, the second Keziah and the third Keren Happuch. In all the land no women were as lovely as the daughters of Job. And their father put them into his will along with their brothers. Job lived 140 years after that, living to see four generations of his children and grandchildren. Then he died an old man having lived a long full life.
