seasonal affective disorder (sad syndrome). Many continue to be anxious about the effects of Covid 19 which has also inhibited our activities, leading us into some dark places mentally. I was talking with a man in the queue at the bank the other day and he was concerned that he would not be able to celebrate Christmas with his whole family as he

Unemployment is rising across the board and we in the Christian community will be needed more than ever to offer

emotional, material and spiritual support to people.

The apostle Paul seemed to rejoice and praise God in adversity, when he was tortured and imprisoned. How many of us could do that with such fortitude. We perceive that there is still a lot of anxiety out there and with an increase in Covid cases likely, we believe that stepping back is the loving and safe thing to do right now.

We have made the decision to defer our AGM, We would prefer to be able to meet in person rather than on Zoom as not all of the team have the technology to do so. Before lockdown we had only four
